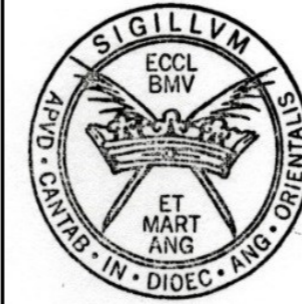

**HOLY WEEK:** is the most intense time of the Church's year. The Liturgy of the Church plunges us deep into the saving mysteries of the Lord's death and resurrection. It is always a good thing to go to Confession in Holy Week as this Sacrament prepares us to live out again our baptismal promises as we pass from our sins to new life. **The Parish Service of Reconciliation will be on Monday 21st March at 19.30.**

**HOLY WEEK LEAFLET:** Please note there are a couple of errors in the leaflet. Children's Stations on Good Friday will be at 11 (*not 10.30*) and Mass on Easter day at Sawston is at the usual time of 11.15 (*not 12.15*) Amended copies of the leaflet are available from the back of church.

**GOOD FRIDAY:** is a day of FASTING and ABSTINENCE.

**FR. PETER** will leave us on Low Sunday (April 3rd) to begin six months sabbatical leave before taking up a new appointment in the diocese. We will have an opportunity to say farewell to Fr. Peter and to express our thanks for his ministry in our parish in due course. A plan is in place, and will be announced shortly, by the Bishop, to ensure a smooth transition and the continued pastoral care of the parish. Fr. Peter is most grateful for the many kind words and messages that he is receiving.

**EASTER LILIES:** You are invited to dedicate a lily in memory of a relative or friend as part of the Easter celebrations. Names will be recorded in a Book of Remembrance and Mass offered on your behalf. Please send your donation of £5 per lily to Jeremy Wong at the Rectory together with your clearly written dedication. Cheques should be made payable to OLEM.

**COLLECTIONS FOR HOLY WEEK AND EASTER SUNDAY: Thursday 24th March (Maundy Thursday)** there will be a collection to support the ministry of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in our Parish.
